

STONE CANYON OUTDOOR EDVENTURES-STUDENT PACKING LIST

In order for your child to be as comfortable and prepared as possible, please look over this packing list closely and adhere to the items and guidelines we have provided. Sudden changes in the weather are not uncommon, and as we believe outdoor education should be outdoors as much as possible, therefore we want your child to be prepared! **Check the weather for Larkspur, CO for the week of your child's Outdoor Education retreat.**

Please be sure that everything your child packs will fit into one suitcase/duffel bag (excluding their small day backpack). This will help ensure that there are no space issues on the bus.

We highly recommend putting your child's name on the italicized items on the checklist in the event that they are lost.

SNACKS

We provide afternoon snacks and all meals. In general, we ask students not to bring extra snacks or candy, unless they are to accommodate a special dietary need. In the case that you need to send supplemental snacks, please communicate this with your student's teacher. Note that we are a nut-aware facility and cannot accept any nuts in foods at camp, regardless of dietary needs.

MEDICATIONS

We adhere to the district policy in regards to the distribution of all medications. ALL medications must be sent in their original container with accurate labels; medications without the original container will NOT be administered. **ALL medications, prescribed or over the counter, are turned into our nurse.**

CONTRABAND

The following items are **not** permitted. Should these items be brought to Stone Canyon, they will be collected and given to the school's teachers and/or administration attending the trip.

- Electronics, including but not limited to: cell phones, smart watches, tablets, laptops, gaming systems
- Matches/lighters
- Pocket knives/multi-tools
- Candy
- Gum
- Aerosol sprays (perfume and deodorants)
- Over the counter medications
- Hair dryers and curling irons
